

## **Noise Management**

Aubin Grove Station and Russell Road Upgrade



## Construction

While as much work as possible will be programmed during normal construction hours, to maintain Mandurah Line services throughout the project, some works will be completed at night when trains are not running.

Residents will be notified in advance of outof-hours work through letterbox drops and updated information on the PTA website.

Noise during these works will be minimised through noise barriers on equipment, selecting the quietest machinery and work methods (where feasible), regularly servicing machinery and investigating the best traffic routes to minimise vehicle movement.













Noise levels will be monitored at stages throughout the project. All work will follow detailed Noise Management Plans and criteria set by the City of Cockburn and Environmental Protection Agency.

## **Station operation**

Detailed noise and vibration modelling has been completed to ensure noise levels from the operational station will not exceed the limits set by the Environmental Protection Authority.

The modelling has found noise levels from the train operations is expected to decrease with the reduced train speeds and stopping patterns taking place, compared to the current case of through traffic.

The new car park and bus transfer facility is expected to create a minimal increase in noise levels, but it will remain within the set limits.
